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## Project Introduction

#### Concept Abstraction

- Every year, millions exchange holiday wish lists to friends & family.
  - Documented or verbally.
- "What do YOU want for Christmas?"
  - Have you asked this question to someone?
  - Have you been asked this question?
  - Anyone ever get a consistent answer from a child?
- Wish lists can change based on context
  - Family, Friends, School, Work, Social Groups, etc.

# Project Introduction

#### Problem Space

- Team attempted to find online applications for the creation, exchange, and management of holiday wish lists
  - Individual companies (Amazon, Best Buy, etc.)
  - One found, but seemed to be more geared toward wedding gifts
- Stress during the holidays can elevate quickly
  - Too much organization already (travel plans, cards, meals, treats, decorations, parties, etc.)
  - Managing ever-evolving wish lists can add to the complexity of the holiday season

# Project Introduction

### Project Vision

- Online, social networking website for family & friends to coordinate holiday wish lists.
  - Reduce stress individuals put on themselves when finding "the perfect gift"
  - Review wish list ideas for all members within a given circle of family & friends
  - Creation of a personalized holiday wish list specific to a given circle of family & friends
  - Ability to mark purchases accordingly to avoid duplication "under the tree"


## Functional Concept

- Primary Website Functionality

- Cognitive Walkthrough & Direction
  - Website should be able to be used by wide range of ages and computer skills.
  - Opportunities presented to combine screens
    - (Maeda Law 1 Reduce! Shrink & Hide)

  - E-mail notifications
  - Social "chat" activities
- Functions remaining
  - Creation of multiple "circles"


#### Test Preparation & Overview

- Three tasks to be performed

# Task Walkthrough & Findings Review

- Task Walkthrough Finding (Highlights)
  - Most tasks were completed successfully
    - A few required a little instruction from test conductors.
  - Everyone flagged the "Maybe" status as confusing
    - The concept was understood, but could better term be used?
  - A few of the prototype screens showed additional functionality not discussed or tested for, but users saw and questioned anyway.
    - Stumble into Alice In Wonderland's "Rabbit Hole"

# Project Conclusions


- Suggested Changes
  - Verbiage Consistency
    - Use of "Account" & "Profile" in a website
  - Re-Label "Maybe"
    - Confusing word in design. Any suggestions?
  - Inclusion of Dependents for individual profile
    - Shown in prototype, but was not concentrated on
    - Should be seriously considered for application success
  - Usability Test Changes itself
    - Initial changing of circle member status
    - Confusion found in transitioning from 2<sup>nd</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> task

# Project Conclusions

- Our own "Wish List" for project design
  - Inclusion of dependent information
    - Critical portion of the site, for kids, spouses, and dependents
  - Expansion of "Wish List Database" concept
    - Birthdays, Easter, Graduations, etc.
  - Inclusion of Social Messaging
    - E-mails, circle chat rooms, progress reports & updates
  - Mobile Device Integration
    - Update circle member statuses immediately
    - Sustainability: no paper needed!
    - Possible direction integration to suggested stores?
